ANALYZE

Examine Community Needs

To enable communities to achieve sustainable impact, the community's needs must be analyzed and understood first in order to identify their root causes.

REVIEW | Monitor and Evaluate Results

It is important to monitor progress throughout the project to determine if the goals and intended impact are on track to be achieved. Finally, analyze data to measure the resulting positive change.



EXECUTE

Take Action

Once the need and root cause have been identified, active citizens take action by mobilizing resources, rallying support and implementing the project plan. By combining resources, the community is enabled to achieve even greater sustainable impact.

DEVELOP | Formulate Sustainable Solutions

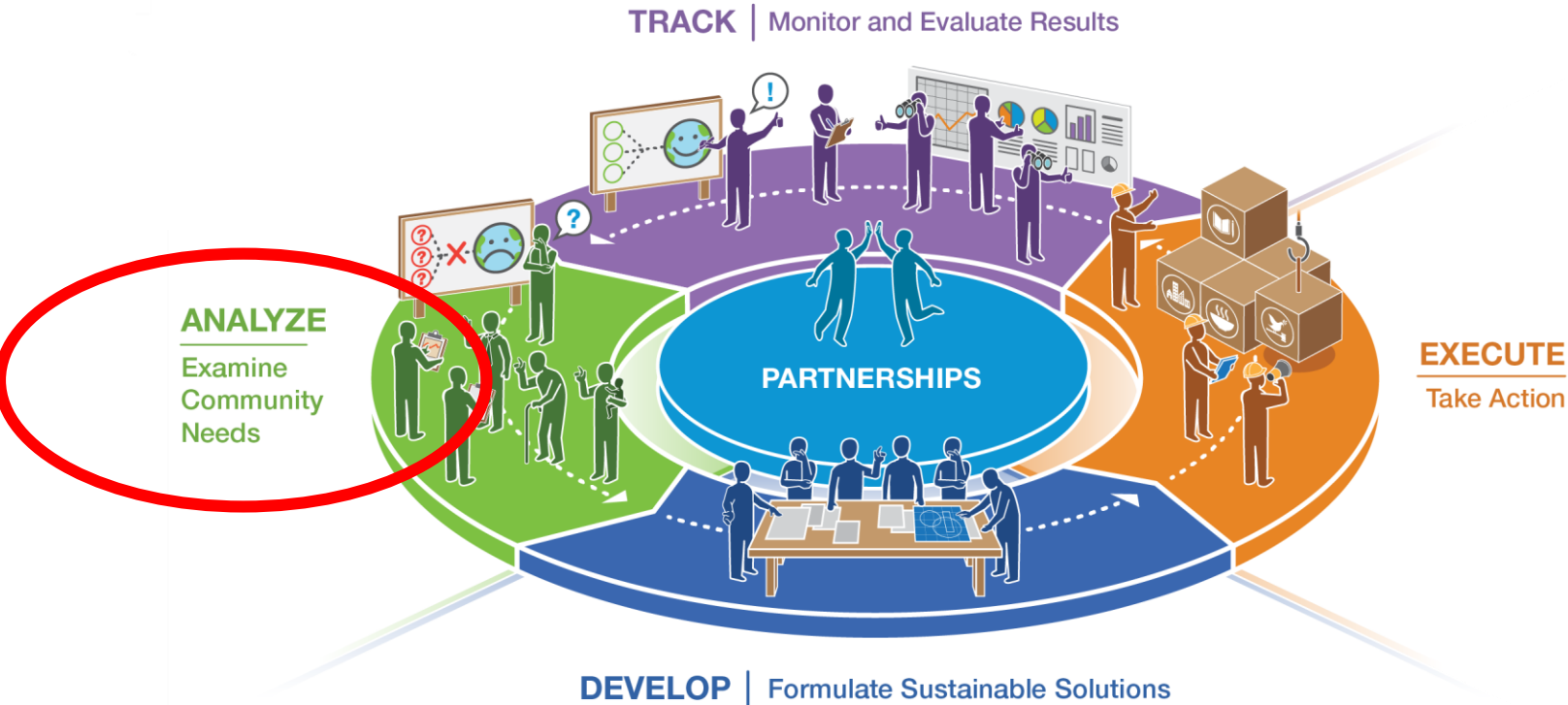
By uniting with stakeholders from all sectors of society, projects are formulated to address the community's core needs and their root causes. ③ Peace, Prosperity, and Sustainability

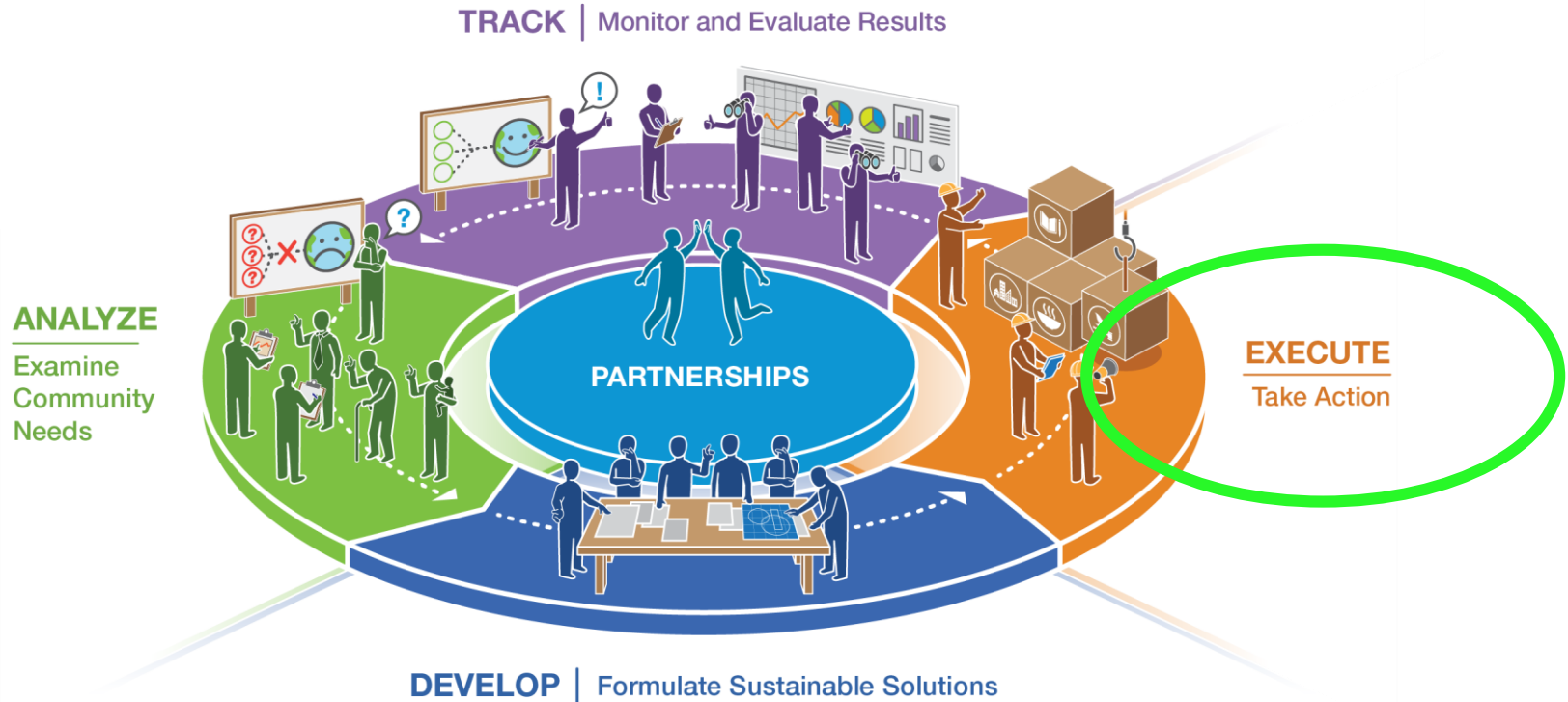

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When to Stop Asking “Why”



- **Keep** asking why during the **cause detection** process.
- **Stop** when action will **reduce the effect** or **eliminate the cause**.
- **Stop** when the **Local Organization** has reached the limit of ability to act.

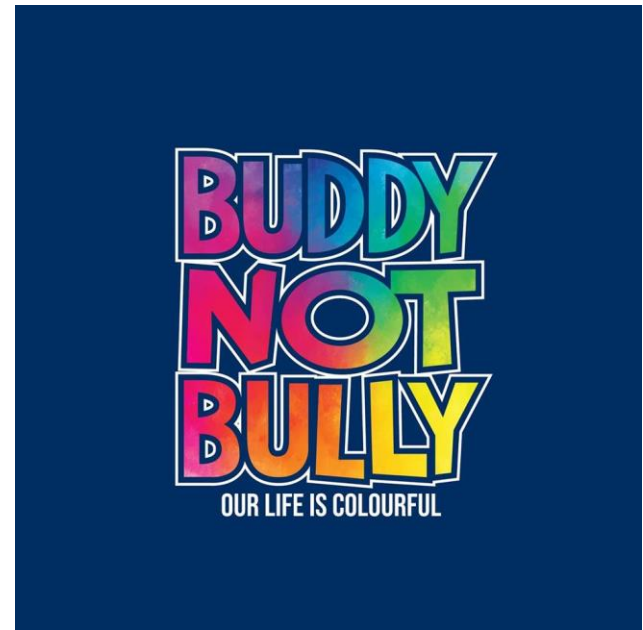

- The program has been well recognized in the local community and impact more than 10,000 local school, college and citizens

Last Straw Johor by JCI South Key

- A series of project in a program to promote the awareness of NO PLASTIC STRAW usage in the state of Johor to ensure the ocean cleanness





- The LO work together with the independent statistic expert to collect the data in plastic straw usage in Johor which cause ocean pollution. They work together with the local state starting from SouthKey to kick start the project



- The program started only less than 9 months but has gain support from the local authority for promotion. The impact of estimation 2,000 pax in the upcoming carnival promotion was supported by local government

Green the School by JCI Pearl

- Statistic from KKM April 2019, 15% of Malaysia children suffering from obesity which is top 1 in Asia Pacific and NCD disease Malaysia being in the top 3 countries in ASEAN for highest percentage of obesity. Pearl identify the problem and found the root cause is lacking of education and awareness.

On top of that we have 100 health ambassador who sponsor for kids to attend workshop and camp.

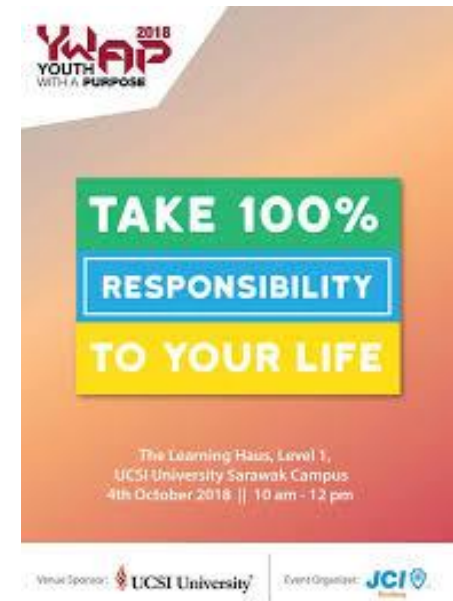
- Obtained statistic from Marine department on the extinction of life on marine and working together with local government to promote importance of certain species of marine life
