MyDigital Corp, Petrosains inks MoU to drive MDEB, IR4



KUALA LUMPUR: MyDigital Corp and Petrosains Sdn Bhd today signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) to drive the Malaysian Digital Economy Blueprint (MDEB) and National Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR) Policy.
