sign showed that the efforts of the government during the pandemic, including eight aid and economic stimulus packages valued at RM530 million, were fruitful.

However, he stated that they were also aware of growing chal-lenges, including the increase in prices of essential food items.

"The Statistics Department reported that food inflation in April rose by 4.1 per cent with 89.1 per cent of food items recording an

increase.
"Multiple factors — including unpredictable weather, international geopolitical situations that affected the global supply chain, increasing prices of agricultural input such as seeds and fertiliser, rising logistics cost and manpower shortages in the agriculture sector - have caused prices of food items to rise."

Muhyiddin said that if this issue persisted, it could disrupt the country's food supply chain and food security, which would burden the people.
