### 2023 Budget: RM6.7 billion for TVET, 55 pct SPM leavers to further studies in TVET

KUALA LUMPUR: The government has targeted 55 per cent of Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) leavers to continue their studies in technical and vocational education and training (TVET).

Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Tengku Abdul Aziz said RM6.7 billion would be allocated to seven related ministries to carry out initiatives through the TVET Council.

"Among them is the RM180million fund for the TVET Training Fund under the Skills Development Fund Corporation, to provide loans that will benefit 12,000 Malaysian Skills Certificate programme trainees.

"The government will also continue the Dual National Training System programme with an allocation of RM20million, benefitting 3,000 trainees," he said when tabling the 2023 Budget in the Dewan Rakyat today.
