Partake in TVET

UTRAJAYA: In a bid to intensify technical and vocational education and training (TVET). Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has suggested that the private sector and government-linked companies (GLC) step up their involvement and cooperation in such efforts. He said this was important to meet the needs of industries and resolve problems such as mismatch between training provided and industry requirements as well as unsatisfactory facilities.

"I have proposed that immediate measures be taken. We have studies and committees to ensure that our children are trained for jobs that provide a reasonable income," he told a press conference after chairing the weekly Cabinet meeting yesterday.

Anwar said for example, Petronas could use its expertise to manage the TVET centre in Pengerang.

Anwar said for example, Petronas could use its expertise to manage the TVET centre in Pengerang, Johot, to cater to the needs of Petronas, and DRB-Hicomi Pekan, Pahang, in the automobile sector while the Sunway and Berjaya groups could provide training in hotel and tourism, and general services.

Apart from this, groups from the business conglomerate owned by Tan Sri Syed Mokhart Albukhary could also participate in TVET or training institutions, he added.

Anwar said the Cabinet committee on TVET would take additional steps, including identifying private companies which could aid government efforts, Bernama reported.

This is a major decision and we have called for immediate action, apart from explaining this in the budget (revised Budget 2023) on Feb 24, said Anwar, who is also finance minister.

He said based on last year's sudget, the allocation for TVET was RM6.7 billion, covering various ministries, departments, agencies and 500 public skills training institutes with a total enrolment of about 250,000 trainees.

He said efforts to strengthen TVET also involved various ministries and departments, including the Higher Education Ministry, Education Ministry, Rural and Regional Development

Ministry, Youth and Sports Ministry, Human Resources Ministry and

Giatmara.

On a separate matter, Anwar said
