Coast Rail Link (ECRL) has reached 39.64 per cent completion up to January.

Transport Minister Anthony

Loke said the route and location of the ECRL stations were finalised after receiving the rail-way scheme approval.

He said the completion date for

Section A (Kota Baru to Dungun), Section B (Dungun to Mentakab), and Section C1 (Mentakab to ITT Gombak) remained as scheduled

for completion by Dec 31, 2026.
Section C2 (Gombak to Port
Klang) was expected to be
completed by Dec 31, 2027, he

said.
"The ECRL will see 2023 as the peak year of its construction, involving beam launching, station building, track laying and other (related) works.
"Most of the construction works are being actively carried."

works are being actively carried out with certain works focused on Section A, Section B and Sec-tion Cla from Kelantan to Pa-

"Among the works are the con-struction of bridges using beam launcher machinery, as well as digging and tunnelling," he said
