Looking at the performance across sub-sectors, Mohd Uzir said, "The growth of 5.8% for retail trade in this month was supported by retail sales in non-specialised stores which supported by retail sales in non-specialised stores which continued its upward trend to register 10.9% or RM2.2 billion to RM22.8 billion. Other groups in this sub-sector also recorded positive growth namely retail sales of automotive fuel 8.5%, retail sales of food, beverages and tobacco 12.6%, retail sales in specialised stores 2.7%, retail sales not in stores, stalls or market 2%, and retail sales in stalls and market 5.8%.

Month-on-month, sales of this sub-sector rebounded 1%, with

Month-on-month, sales of this sub-sector rebounded 1%, with most of the groups registered a positive growth.

Mohd Uzir said the increase of 3.1% in wholesale trade was

3.1% in wholesale trade was attributed to wholesale of food, beverages & tobacco which rose RM0.9 billion or 7.8% to RM12.2 billion. This was followed by wholesale of household goods 4.8%, wholesale of agricultural raw materials and live animals raw materials and live animals trade 11.4%, wholesale on a fee or contract basis 9.2%, and wholesale of machinery,

cquipment and supplies 1.1%.
For monthly comparison, wholesale trade rose 0.3%, mainly attributable to other specialised wholesale and wholesale of household goods which increased 2.7% and 0.6%, respectively.
Mohd Uzir said, "The 3.4% growth for motor vehicles subsector in this month was pushed up by sales of motor vehicles parts & accessories and maintenance & repair motor vehicles with 18.3% and 20%,

respectively. However, sales of motor vehicles declined -3.8%. For monthly comparison, this sub-sector slipped -1.9%, dragged down by sales of motor vehicles with -4.7%."

The year-on-year increase of 5.7% in second quarter this year for wholesale & retail trade was underpinned by retail trade subunderpinned by retail trade sub-sector which expanded RM13 billion or 7.8% to RM178.7 billion. This was followed by wholesale trade which rose 3.6% or RM6.4 billion to reach RM185.5 billion. Motor vehicles sub-sector also grew with 6.2% or RM2.8 billion to record RM48.3 billion in this quarter. qu arter.

For index of retail sale over the internet, the index recorded 1.5% growth year-on-year in June as compared to -0.8% in May. For seasonally adjusted value, the index edged up 0.8% as against

the previous mo In terms of volume index, wholesale & retail trade for June wholesale & retail trade for June registered a year-on-year growth of 3.1%. The expansion was attributed to all sub-sectors namely wholesale trade 4.5%, motor vehicles 3.1%, and retail motor vehicles 3.1%, and retail trade 2.6%.
