Ekuinas CEO to step down on March 31

NINE YEARS AT THE HELM

Ekuinas CEO to step down on March 31

KUALA LUMPUR: Ekuiti Nasional Bhd (Ekuinas) has announced that Datuk Syed Yasir Arafat Syed Abd Kadir will step down as chief executive officer (CEO) on March 31, concluding a 15-year tenure with the company, including nine years as CEO.

Since taking the helm in 2016, Syed Yasir Arafat has played a role in transforming Ekuinas into a leading private equity firm, managing RM4 billion in funds under management and deploying RM5.6 billion in economic capital across 28 companies.

He led the creation of Dana Asas, a Bumiputerafocused private equity fund, and introduced private credit as a new investment asset class.
